

Virginia Beach Mustangs Code of Conduct

The Virginia Beach Mustangs require that the following Code of Conduct applies to **ALL PARTICIPANTS** in our program. This includes all Youth Participants, Coaches, Volunteers, Parents, Guardians, and guests at any Virginia Beach Mustang activity.

By signing this form, I agree that I will refrain from the following:

- The use of alcohol or illegal drugs
 - Profanity or inappropriate language.
 - Taunting, hazing or any other degrading activity.
 - Arguing or showing disrespect to football coaches, officials or opponents or teammates.
 - Any adult who becomes verbally or physically aggressive with or attempts to intimidate an official, coach, player, volunteer or anyone attending the event, will be asked to leave that event. In addition, his or her child(ren) may be asked to leave that event as well.
 - Any second, similar offense that could result in a ban from attending any Mustangs event for the remainder of the season and their child(ren) may be suspended for the remainder of the season.
 - All adults will refrain from any verbal or written defamation of character of another adult, volunteer, coach, etc. This includes social media. Such offense will be subjected to the same terms outlined above in this section.
 - Any adult who physically assaults an official, coach, player, volunteer, or parent/guardian will be banned from participation and their child removed from participation for ONE year from the date of the offense. Upon the completion of the 1-year suspension, parents may reapply for reinstatement. Physical assault includes, but is not limited to: hitting, striking, slapping, pushing, spitting, kicking or striking in any way with any part of the body or the usage of any physical implement as a weapon.
 - Non volunteers are strictly prohibited from being on the playing field/sidelines during practices/games unless they are a organization appointed volunteers.
